PROGRAM:

Neil WILLIAMS, Senior Development Officer Kelowna Hospital Foundation

- moved to Kelowna 6 months ago from Calgary
- Provincial Government has contributed over \$1B towards the expansion of KGH which only covers basic equipment
- KGH is a teaching hospital in support of UBCO medical programs and it is therefore the primary goal of the KGH Foundation to ensure that the very best of equipment is procured to enable the facility to become a centre of excellence. The fund raising target is \$12M
- the new surgical centre is scheduled to open in September introducing 15 state of the art operating rooms, including a "hybrid" operating theatre where multiple procedures can be completed allowing the patient to stay put and the surgical teams rotate.
- 4th floor of the new surgical centre will house a new state of the art Neo-Natal Intensive Care facility. The NICU will eliminate the need to send the sickest of babies to Vancouver.
- 3rd floor of surgical centre is designated as "mechanical" which will house all of the sterilization equipment for the hospital.
- KGH will always be a work in progress as new technologies and procedures are developed. Public support will always be critical for growth and improvement.

As a matter of interest the Capri Rotary Club on behalf of all the Rotary Clubs in Area 4 that participated in the Festival Lights presented the KGH Foundation (NICU) with a cheque for \$17K (included matching grant)
