Art POST, Okanagan Men's Shed Organization

- Men's Sheds originated in Australia where a workshop is referred to as a shed
- The Okanagan Men's Shed is a community workshop type environment where men can work on projects and socialize at the same time.
- Becoming a member of gives a man a safe and busy environment where he can find old fashion friendship in a safe and busy environment. It is based on the concept that "Men don't easily talk face to face; they talk shoulder to shoulder.
- Men's Shed has proven to be one of the most powerful tools to assist men combat and overcome isolation through death of a loved one, retirement etc. and to help restore self esteem.
- Some examples of shed activities include work working, card games, toy making, restoring bicycles etc.
- The Okanagan Shed has 15 members and they meet monthly in the workshop at Hawthorne Park.
