- 1. ROTARY 101 Jim HAWKINS
 - Part 1 of a 3 Part Presentation that the DG has instructed that the ADG's give to all of the Rotary Clubs in District 5060.
 - Overall an excellent presentation on the Objectives of Rotary and the "new" Direction of Rotary. The presentation generated a positive dialogue between the presenter and the Club Members.
 - The highlights and main focus centred on Membership, Leadership (RLI), Foundation and Fellowship (Having Fun)
 - Membership and membership retention continues to be and always will be a challenge for clubs for a variety of reasons. (Age; Time – family commitments vs Rotary; other alternatives such as One Hundred Men Who Give a Damn; Lack of understanding what Rotary is all about etc)
 - It was agreed that our Club will have to develop a Membership Strategy to attract new Members. We should try and find individuals who are between 40 and 50 years of age. Ideally it would be beneficial to attract persons are willing to in time, assume leadership roles in the Club to ensure succession and survival of the Club.
 - A recent study showed that overall Rotary Membership is stagnant....overall numbers have not changed over the past 10 years. The same study concluded that 30% of new Rotarians joined for Friendship and consequently 38% stayed in Rotary for friendship. Additionally 35% of new Rotarians joined to have an impact on their community and subsequently stayed when this objective was satisfied. Interestingly only 8% joined Rotary to have a Global impact.
