STARBRIGHT CHILDREN'S DEVELOPMENT (SRDC) - Karina FRISQUE

- SCDC is a not for profit/fee for service organization providing intervention services to families with children experiencing developmental delays and physical challenges. There are a wide range of programs offered including Autism; Hippotherapy; Theraputic Horse Back Riding; Occupational Therapy; Speech Therapy etc
- Karina is a Team Leader in the Autism Spectrum Disorder Program. There has been considerable research on "autism" and it has been established that each case is unique, therefore one on one treatment, albeit costly is the best approach to achieving success.
- The SCDC Autism Spectrum Disorder Program is limited to children aged up to six years. The program is focused on increasing the childs ability to function positively within their family and community.
- In the USA 1 in 68 children will be diagnosed with some type of Autism Spectrum Disorder. No statistics for Canada per se but it is believed that the number would be similar. Autism Spectrum Disorder is definitely on the rise however despite numerous unproven theories such as child immunization etc there is nothing concrete to explain why?. The most plausible reason is that more child behaviour problems are now being diagnosed and treated as autism spectrum disorder.
- The SCDC autism program is costly as it is a one on one program. The use of iPods is now an integral part of the program and they are in desperate need of support to purchase new equipment.
